

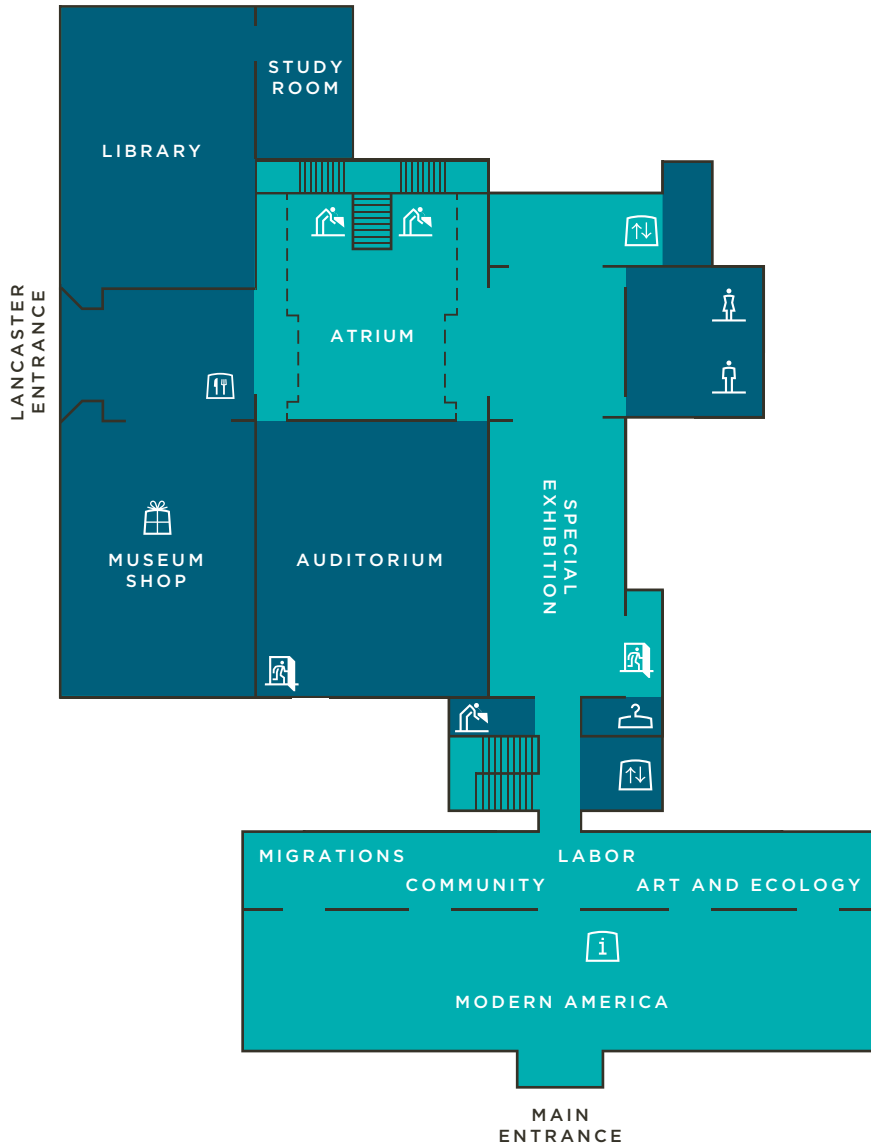

Map



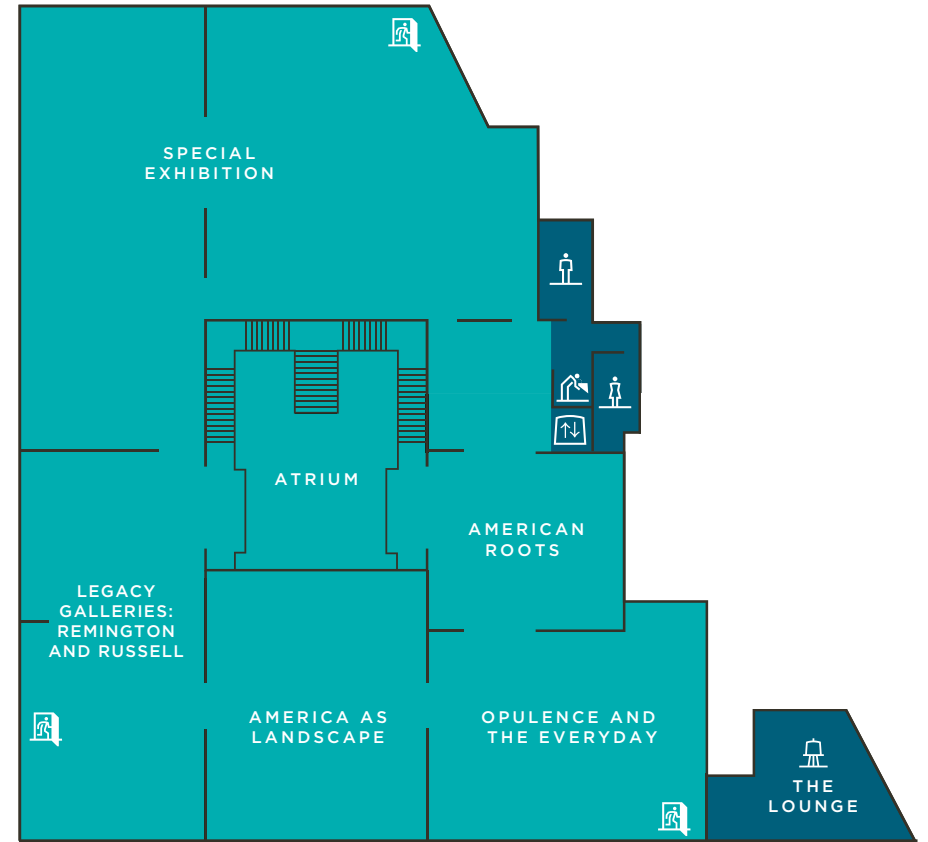
First Floor

20th-Century Collection and Special Exhibitions

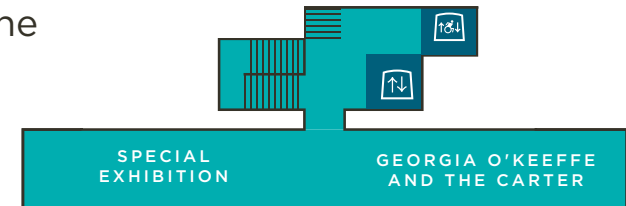


Second Floor
