Biographical Note

John Frederick Kensett was part of the second generation of Hudson River School artists known for his landscapes and mastery of luminism. Kensett was born March 22, 1816, in Cheshire, Connecticut, to parents Thomas and Elizabeth Daggett Kensett. Around 1828 he began training as an engraver with his father and uncle, Alfred Daggett, in New Haven. He briefly trained in New York with Peter Maverick, though the death of his father in 1829 brought him back to New Haven. After a falling out with his uncle in 1835, Kensett left to work with various engravers until 1840. Throughout this time, Kensett formed lifelong friendships with other engravers and artists including John Casilear and Thomas P. Rossiter. With these friends, Kensett traveled to England to study painting with the goal of becoming a landscape painter. They first connected with members of the extended Kensett family at Hampton Court before moving to Paris. He spent the next several years traveling and studying across Europe and began sending early landscapes back to New York for exhibition. After returning to the States in late 1847, Kensett became a staple in the social art scene as an early member of the Century Association and an elected associate of the National Academy of Design in 1848 and 1849. He helped establish the Artists' Fund Society, served on the presidential committee that advised on decoration of the U.S. Capitol building, and assisted in establishing the Metropolitan Museum of Art, where he was one of the founding trustees. In 1867 he purchased land on an island off the coast of Connecticut, where he built a studio to work on the coastal views that he had gained a reputation for. Kensett died December 14, 1872, while recovering from jumping into the water off the island in an attempt to save his friends' wife, who drowned. His funeral was held at the National Academy of Design, and an exhibition of his paintings was shown at the Metropolitan Museum in 1873.

Scope and Content Note

The Kellogg Collection of John Frederick Kensett Family Papers spans from 1792 to 1983 (bulk 1830-1875) and contains correspondence from Kensett, his family, and friends, along with materials related to his artworks, financial records, newspaper clippings, publications, and ephemera from his travels.
