

BRITISH FLIERS HARASS POE.

Airmen Attacked a Hostile Airdrome
and Trains.

LONDON, Aug. 13, 1918. An official communication issued tonight by the air ministry says:

"On the night of August 12-13 our air machines attacked a hostile airdrome and trains, anti-aircraft batteries and other targets. All our machines returned safely.

"On the 13th, the airdrome at Buhl was attacked. The results were not observed owing to bad visibility.

"One hostile machine was brought down inside our lines."
