Frank says she is doing as well as can be, though he is of course keeping her very quiet for a few days.

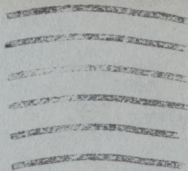
She was wonderfully brave throughout it all,
