father more every day

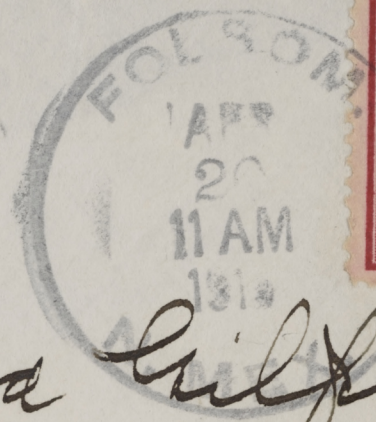
pink - at a little porch at-
