times together.

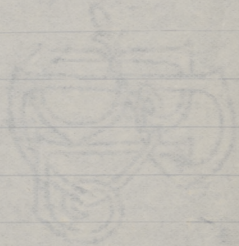

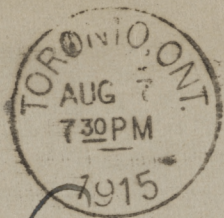
