night and all night?

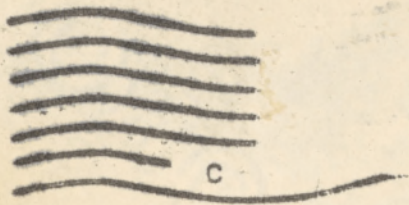
I got fine and rested
