Dear Mrs. Simon:-

As it seems impractical for me to continue as the Chairman of the committee for the publication of the Memorial Book of Clarence H. White, I reluctantly hand you my resignation. I have felt it a great honor to be this chairman, and it is only that I fear that my living so far away will hinder the work, that I resign. It is very difficult to act as the head of a committee from this distance. I should like to resign in favor of Mrs. Ullman, one member of this committee. She has had much experience in the making of such a book as we propose, and she will carry through the work very ably. But I hope that I may remain a member of the committee for there will be things that I can do from here, and I shall most gladly do anything in my power to help make this Memorial the fine thing we all wish it to be.

Mrs. Ullman has a copy of the letter which we propose to send out regarding the book. I strongly urge that we try to raise the money for the photogravure book. I believe that we will succeed

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with it, but in the event that we fail, we can then resort to another medium. It seems to me that the publication of this book is the most important thing now before the Alumni Asso. Our problem is to sell five hundred copies of the book at fifteen dollars each. With concentrated and sincere effort on our part, I am sure that we can do this. The estimates which I obtained while in New York were somewhat indefinite until we could lay the actual material before the printer. But the sum of \$7500.00 will fully cover all expenses. I enclose herewith my check for ten dollars to go toward the sum which it will be necessary for us to raise at once to cover the cost of the printed circular. And I should like to see Mrs. Ullman's fine portrait of Mr. White used on it. I feel that it would be important to present an appealing circular, one beautifully designed and printed. Some of us must meet this preliminary expense.

It is a great disappointment to me that I am not with you at this meeting, but I am sure that it needs no urging on my part that the Alumni as a whole as well as in part put their best efforts into the success of this book.
