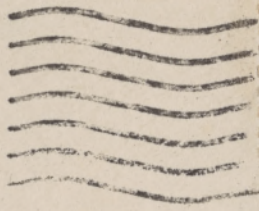
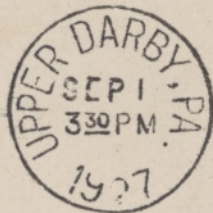
I want you to know my heartfelt sympathy for you in your great sorrow. You have always been so good and kind to me and I am so far away from you now.
