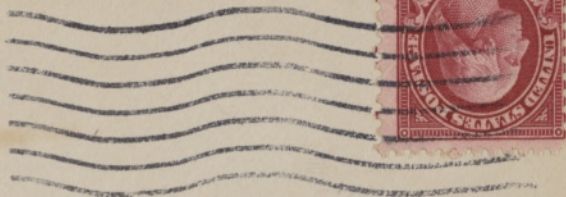
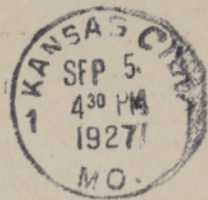
Dear Laura,
