Your letter with the checks enclosed and the letter containing the list of prints sold have been received. I am verypleased over the sale of the platinum prints to Mr. Emerson. I am enclosing my check for \$13.50, 15%, for the commission. As these prints cost so much to make I have never been able to put them out at dealers giving them their high commission and keep the selling price within possible range. Where ever these have been sold as museums or exhibitions the commission has been 10%. But I am very glad to make it 15% to the Mesa Verde.

I regret to note that so few copies of the book have been sold. Have youany reasons to offer and any suggestions to offer that will stimulate sales?

If it meets with the approval of Mr Nusbaum I will repace the platinum prints before the season opens next year so that you may have the set complete then.

I hope that you have all had a very successful year. It have been a disappointment to

me not to get down again this year. I had hoped to this ~~month~~ but I do not see how I can possibly do it now.
