My dear Miss Gilpin:

Your letter of April 23rd seems to indicate just what I expected, namely, that you are not wholly satisfied with the results of photographing Grace Church after a snowstorm.

Of the three exterior views, the smallest is to my mind the best, and I am just wondering if this picture, which is rather a narrow one, includes on the negative any of the west gable of the church proper. If it does, then I believe we shall ask you to include prints of this among the finished order. Without the front gable the picture seems to be a little incomplete, and one is apt to wonder why the gable is left off.

Would you mind making another try for some good views of the exterior, and do not forget the one taken almost directly in front of the church, at about two o'clock in the afternoon, with the sun out. The shadows on the two exterior views in which the sun is shining seem to be just about right.

We hope you are now making good progress with the interiors.

We are returning the two exteriors which have the ugly trees in the foreground, and are keeping, for the present at least, the one referred to above.
