I do not remember writing to you to acknowledge receipt of the beautiful pictures of Grace Church, Colorado Springs, which reached us a week or ten days ago.

The exterior view looks very much better in the silver print on the rough paper than it did with the other finish.

For the interiors, especially the ones showing the main altar and reredos, I think the smooth paper is better. There is a chance to compare the two finishes on one of these. On the rough surface most of the detail is lost, while on the other one you have the detail, and yet the effect is very soft.

The vista through the arch from the chapel, looking at the main altar, is very interesting and beautiful. Thank you very much for the time and trouble you have spent in getting these very satisfactory results.
