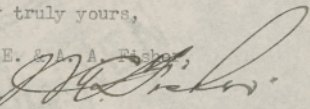
My dear Miss Gilpin:

Gentlemen:

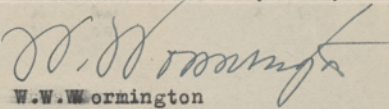
I wish to thank you for your letter
