I am planning to use the Goudy Kennerley type, using the Italic Capitals for the title page and headings for the body of the text we can use either the Italic lower case letter or the regular Kennerley face. I believe that the whole thing would look very well in Italic as the face has a hand quality about it that is in keeping with the school. I enclose a list of the photographs that will go in the booklet and trust that this selection is correct. They are all ready to go to the Engraver upon the final word from you. A reddish brown ink will be used wherever color will add to the appearance of the booklet. I have gone over the text very carefully and have a few errors on the part of the typist which I have corrected and when you receive the proof will you go over personally and also have one or two others do the same? It is always surprising how many simple errors can slip by. Of course we will also check it very carefully here as well. It would be a help in setting the type to have the paragraph headings now. On a booklet of this kind I design ~~at~~ ^a page by page which is difficult to do unless I have the entire text as I do not know how much space to allow for the headings and this type will all be set by hand rather than by the linotype machine.

Should any of the Boys wish copies of the photographs that I am sending, prints of this kind are \$5.00 each. Platinum prints such as these I had

with me at Los Alamos are \$10.00. I shall send you one platinum print in a day or two that you may compare them. Will you have the text for the little insert ready soon? As soon as I hear from you regarding the number of booklets desired, the type whether Italic or regular, the headings, etc. I will proceed at once with the booklet and we will have it ready for you as soon as possible.
