My dear Laura.

Was nice to have a little talk with
you some ago since I left home practically
5 last five days. I was alarmed about my
condition the other night in camp at
Gibbonsville Idaho where I went to see
Lafferty. I tried to get up but could not
keep my balance and even lying down
things were unsteady. Moved into a cabin
a last there two days with poor attention
could walk around a bit. On third
day came to Butte. Stayed at a
lowest camp (rather full of Rocks
actors noisy) Came here next morning
thurs. being the third day. Was up awhile

This morning and made a business
Call but was pretty shady. and am
still so. I have been free from worries
as I have been occupied with in-
teresting things constantly and tired out at
night have slept well. Took my dose
Colonel last night by Webb's orders, but
am still floating. Heart & Kidneys
etc. So don't know just what it is
I have had a queer feeling for a long time
in the back of my neck which now
seems to be the centre of trouble. I am
not letting it worry me but it's
most annoying. The McFarland
Creek deal. which came up to be
is still in the air for good reason
which I will explain when we meet

I have found ³ another place that
looks as though it might produce some
quick money. and came here to get
a lease on it Am waiting to see
V.P. of ~~Am~~ Concha Baffin May 6
to get lease signed. All preliminaries
are pretty well arranged I could not
go on even though I had the lease
as I am not able. Hope however
to be out of here in couple of days
It is expensive and don't know
just when the money is coming from
but as I can't help it am not
worrying. Days have been very hot
a nights cold. Better get in touch
with me before you leave home
again. I will write you in few days

Looking at date of your letter Aug
 7th fear you will soon be off again
 If I am not better will be Compelled
 to come home but feel that I must
 get the Aconda Lear finished up
 as I have a good piece more ready
 to pour me in working it. So even if
 I am Compelled to go home that can
 go on. Feel as though I was giving
 the more & more of a care to you

 on business? Hope to hear from him
 soon - Sorry I can't give you any
 definite plans Think I had better
 lay low here few days in any event
