This is the beginning of the fourth night
and the end of the fifth day and I see little
improvement. I got up a while this morning
walked about 24 blocks and went back to bed
My head aches that gives feeling of vertigo
and I am very unsteady on my feet
not from weakness but from the condition of
my head My business work is just beginning to
count. I have a lease promised me here
by the Alameda Co. and am waiting
for the Vice Pres. to return to sign it.
Also Buckner of Hampshire shows
signs of coming to our terms for
a loan and loan with no cash
down so I feel as though I can not

Care until their two things are closed
The Hospital Charge only \$5.00 per day
for every thing. Excepting, I suppose the
do do is not so very expensive
and if I could see any improvement
I would not mind so far I don't think
they have any idea what ails me and
I am sure I haven't except the
pain and draw feeling I have had for
so long a time across the back of my
neck It is in this region I am sure
that the trouble comes that disturbs
my head and gives me the semi
fainting spells. I may feel better in
the morning though I was better yesterday
but am now about where I started
shut & feel rather thin now but have had
a lot of brownies yesterday

It is just 8 am. but as the Air Mail
leave at 9 must get this to P.O.

Keep track of time from here to C.S.
via Air. I think letter goes to Salt Lake
from here no direct line to Cheyenne
