After an unexpectedly long absence I have just returned and I have just gone over the proofs of the group of photographs that were made for the Colo. Springs Psychopathic Hospital to-gether with the proofs you have sent down. I regret to state that I am very disappointed in most of them and do not think that they are up to your usual standard.

I am returning eight of them marked on the proofs and one which had a mark on the corner which somehow showed up far worse in the plate. This however should not have been there at all. I did not see it on the print that was sent to you and I regret that you did not call my attention to it as this plate will have to be re-made. I enclose a new print. Most of these are weak and lacking in highlight detail.

Please give them your considered thought and I am sure that you will return me some far better proofs. Owing to my delay in returning to the city, we are late with this job, so that I will appreciate your prompt attention.
