Dear Dr. Brady:-

Under separate cover I am mailing you a copy of the booklet I made for the Glockner Hospital as a sample. Also enclosed is a blank dummy for weight and size. This 16 page booklet has been made up to the limit of the $1\frac{1}{2}$ cent postage weight. An extrag page is included for the weight of the ink and another for a letter which you might wish to enclose with the booklet. The paper, however, is not the paper that would be used, as a surface similar to the Glockner book is necessary for the printing of the plates I will show you various samples of colors for the cover for your selection.

I wish to call your attention to the way in which the Glockner cover is made, a French Fold. This uses a double sheet of cover stock and is made in a way that the metal stitches do not show, giving a much nicer appearance to the booklet.

The following estimate is not exact owing

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to the fact that at this time it is not possible to figure the size of the plates, but it is very near the correct figure. This price includes using a better grade of paper to insure good reproductions of the pictures, the use of overlays in printing the plates, the half-tone plates and twelve new photographs, everything complete

This price includes envelopes, the printing, my supervision and design and my photographs.
