To date I have not received the enlargement of the Shove Chapel which I sent to you on approval last week. Did you send it to Chicago or are you returning it direct to me?

I am sorry if you think the charge of \$2.00 high on that picture. This is the price I get on all architectural work. You wouldn't get much of a picture of that problem for 50%. I used \$1.00 worth of plates to get it and only made four exposures. You cannot get satisfactory results of such a difficult problem without good materials and they cost considerably more.

The trees will be about right this week I think for the night floodlight picture which Mr. Gray has commissioned me to do. I will certainly have it by next week. I am waiting until the foliage comes out a little as it will make a much more attractive picture.
