Dear Mr. Gray:

After you had left I realized that 16 x 20 enlargements were much larger than I had been thinking about. My work table is not long enough to accomodate such a long projection nor have I trays large enough. So I have sent my negatives up to H.A. Haanstad, 404 Sixteenth St. Denver, and he will make the enlargments for you. I have given him v ry careful instructions as to trimming, mounting, etc. and have sent him a second set of proofs as well. I also told him that you must have these by Feb. 5.

I am mailing you the new proofs as well as two of the first set. They are all numbered, your proofs Hanstaad's proofs and the negatives so that all you will have to do will be to indicate which numbers you wish. I was not able to get another general view, and as Standley has one that will do for you, I trust that this will be all right. The weather did not behave very well. I enclose, however, the one I showed you the other day. This will enlarge so well that you may want to consider it. There are two proofs of the Chancel.

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No. 3 I think is the better. By the way have you noticed that the large chair, the one that is secured to the floor, is not directly in the middle? This negative should yield an excellent enlargement.

No. 5. is not proofed quite deep enough. This was a hard one! To include the tower. The lines are not quite straight, but are not enough off to matter greatly, I hope. Nos 8 & 9 are what you want I hope.

If you will send your selection to Mr. Haanstad he will do good work I am sure.

As soon as I return, in about two weeks, I will proceed with some of the other things that you want, and I do hope that I have been able to get things that will satisfy you for the Architectural League.
