I know Mattie Edwards Hewitt's work though I have never met her. For some years I have done all the work for W.E. Fisher & A.A. Fisher, Architects of Denver, also I have done work for Mr John Gray of Pueblo besides work for a number of private individuals. I use a wide angle lens for private houses where the rooms are not very large. Proper lighting and a good composition are of-course the essentials. In all instances I submit proofs for your choice.

My prices are \$5.00 for the first print, either matt or glossy, \$3.50 on duplicate matt prints and \$2.00 on glossy. The size is 8 x 10.

While most of my work is portrait or landscape, I have in the last few years done a great deal of architectural work as well, and I believe that I will be able to secure what you wish.

After this week, I will be free to proceed with your work at any time.
