There must have been a mistake about the Brovira Velvet as I did not find it in the shipment. There was an extra dz. Matt, the same as the gro. I ordered, which I presume was put in by mistake. If you will charge me with this and send me a sample of the velvet I will be glad to try it.

Will you send me 24 dz. 4 x 5 Portrait Pan films. I am going on a trip to Yucatan and am anxious to have just as fresh stock as possible owing to the tropical conditions in which I will have to work. I am leaving here on March 26, and want these here in time to pack them in a tin box to go in my trunk. If you have any special advice for handling under these conditions I will be very glad to have it. I have tried out a method of adding formaline to the desensitizer having that bath, developer and hypo at a temp. of 84 degrees and wash water at 86, and have obtained films with a hard emulsion on absolutely no frill.

Have you by any chance a 5x7 view camera for sale cheap? My 8x10 is too big and too expensive

to take on this trip. I had hoped to get a new 5x7 but I just cant make it right now. Should you have such an outfit without lens or shutter, will you wire me before you fill this order for the 4x5 films, giving length of bellows extension, and price, or could you make me a monthly payment plan on a new outfit?
