Dear Miss Gilpin:

We have your letter of recent date and in reply.

Upon receipt of your wire we sent the order for Camera and Film out to you C.O.D. for one-third of the entire amount. At that time we were not aware of the fact you were sending in your check.

And upon receipt of your check in the amount of \$15.00, inasmuch as the package had already gone forward C.O.D. for one-third of the total amount of the invoice, we rebilled this merchandise, putting the Camera on one invoice and the Films on a separate charge. At the same time we sent your check (\$15.00) into the factory to apply on the invoice for Films. And we will consider the C.O.D. amount (\$22.62 which is one-third as referred to above) as the down payment on the Camera - the remainder to be paid in two monthly payments as per contract attached.

We forwarded this check to the factory for upon referring to our records we find you are a bit in arrears on your account as it now stands at the factory, so we sent this \$15.00 check in to apply on same.

We sincerely hope our action in this matter meets with your approval. And may we ask that you please go before a Notary Public and have the attached contract properly endorsed, returning the original for our files and retaining the carbon for your records.
