I regret that the prints which you submitted for our recent Annual Exhibition did not arrive in time to enable me to submit them to the Selecting Committee and Judges and as you wish to submit your application for admission to the Fellowship for consideration by the Committee at their meeting this month I am keeping your prints as evidence of your work in support of your application as, at the time of writing, we have not received any prints from you for this purpose.
