It is a long time since your letter reached me regarding my exhibition of photographs. I have been waiting to hear again from California as to when the last showing will end so that I could give you definite dates.

The exhibition is now at Scripps College and will be free Jan. 20th. It is booked again for March first at the University of Oklahoma, and will be available again for April first.
