My dear Miss Gilpin

Just before I left I asked Mrs. Hare to advise you that I would very much like to secure a copy of your lecture and lantern slides on the Southwest, at the fee which you named of \$150.00.

We would also like very much to engage your photographs of Mayan architecture, which are now on exhibition in the Colorado Springs Art Center, for an exhibit here at our Museum.
