Dear Randall:

I was quite disappointed this morning when I finally had a meeting with Laura Gilpin in regard to the booklet we are getting out showing the photographs of your murals. I cannot understand why there is so much difficulty in getting out this booklet.

I wrote to Laura on May 12th to hurry the matter along as the season was advancing rapidly, and up to date I have gotten little or nothing. Therefore, I told her to send you tomorrow the four proofs which you desire. These proofs must be back here by the 9th or 10th of July, or otherwise we will go ahead with the booklet as best we can and put a memorandum in the booklet that it was gotten up hastily and the second edition will be more complete.

People are going up to the Shrine pretty rapidly. Yesterday 180 went through the Shrine. On July 16th we expect to have four thousand cars filled with Elks and Chief Harper of Colorado Springs estimates there will be fifteen or sixteen thousand people, so you can see the necessity of getting the booklet out even if it is incomplete.

Therefore, as soon as you get the proofs do the best you can and send the necessary proofs to Mr. Sloan and ask him to write up his preface and send it to me by airmail so that we can get it in the booklet, otherwise we will go ahead without it.

This booklet will do you as much good as any of us and I hope you will cooperate in every way you possibly can to make it a success.
