My dear Mrs. Van Stone:-

My prints are off to you to-day in two packages. It was better to separate sizes. There may be more prints than you wish to show, in which case please make your own selection. There are 47 prints in the Yucatan series, 33 large prints and 14 smaller ones. Then I have included 18 Southwest prints 5 large and 13 smaller ones.

I sincerely hope that you will find the group of interest. May I caution you about the paper on which the Yucatan prints are made. It is called Gaveluxe, a Belgian paper, very effective in its texture, but quite easily marred as I am sorry to say you will notice on some prints as they bear the marks of previous showings. Also this paper needs to be lighted just right or else the blacks grey out badly. However, I am sure that your lighting will be good. The prints are all titled on the back. In the wild possibility of any sales, I can send you prices. I believe the Southwest are priced. The Yucatan are \$10. 15. and 25. depending on the print. The Sunburst print is \$25. as it is very difficult to make. Most of the other large ones are \$15. The mounts are somewhat the worse for several shows but I hope that they will look well enough. In the event of a sale, I would prefer to remount the print and deliver it from here.
