Due to the political situation in Europe, he has now decided to bring Mrs. Petri with him to this country and remain throughout the year.

Because of the necessity to curtail expenses, we have found it impossible so far to give you a further order for pictures or posters. However, we would like to if we are able to work out a western tour after the first of the year. I am wondering if you know Mrs. Marie Olcott of Grand Junction who wrote Mrs. Edward last March regarding Dr. Petri. If three or four concerts could be planned in Colorado after the first of the year, I am sure that we could work out satisfactory terms.
