Dear Mr. Helms:

Thank you for your letter which has been some days unanswered owing to absence from town.

The cost on glossy prints of which I already have the negatives would be \$1.00 each. These are very carefully made prints to insure correct values of the murals for reproduction. If you should wish any new work the cost for making the first print would be \$5.00 and the above price on duplicates.

I can make enlargements of the Lockwood murals from the negative I had which will be fairly satisfactory but will not be as good as a contact print made from new negatives of a larger size.
