Dear Miss Gilpin:

Thank you for your card of September 27 with the word that you will be able to send your article for the book MY FAVORITE CAMERA AND LENS AND WHY within the next week.

I have recently discussed the layout of the book with Mr. Fraprie of Photographic Publishing Company in Boston and he has made some suggestions as to the best approach to the articles.

He points out that the war has stopped importation of foreign cameras and lenses and thinks for this reason that more emphasis should be placed on methods and less of equipment. His recommendation in this respect is that each contributor choose three of his favorite prints and explain how each was made, together with biographical notes and personal views on the best methods to pursue in obtaining outstanding pictures. The naming of various favorite lenses and cameras would also be included, but this would not be featured as had been the original thought.

I am passing on this information with the hope that it will reach you in time to be of use in the preparation of your article. I will be very glad to take care of postage charges and will return the prints promptly as soon as the necessary cuts have been made.
