We are very sorry that none of the
new sets were on display at Santa Fe. All of the
first lot of these sets were sent to Gallup prior
to the Ceremonial with the idea of returning the
surplus supply after the Ceremonial and sending
them to Santa Fe. During my absense from the City
this matter was overlooked.

each of the following sets to help out our display
at the Santa Fe Units;

May we also ask you to send us ten
envelopes for No. 3 Mesa Verde, one for No. 2 Acoma,
