Dear Miss Gilpin:

I am sending you today two packages, by insured mail. One package contains a glass negative and an ordinary negative, with six platinum prints of each. It is No. 301 on the enclosed list. The second package contains the other pictures on the enclosed list.

As you will note, on this list there are 31 photographs mentioned, all of which are to go in my album -- excepting those which are not as good as similar pictures already in Mrs. Stewart's album, of which you have the negatives. No. 315 is such a picture as I refer to. Please note my request that No. 319 be substituted for the picture of E. C. Markham which appears in Mrs. Stewart's album. Also, No. 321 is to be substituted for Alfred Cowles' picture No. 8, Volume 1, in Mrs. Stewart's album. Otherwise, I think this list is clear.

I shall have some more pictures to send to you -- probably eight or ten.

As I have written you before, I think, my idea is to have all the pictures made -- then we can consider the form of the album and the placing of

the pictures on the pages of the album. I have endeavored to label each picture, so as to avoid any possibility of confusion. As yet I have not been able to prepare the lines to go under all these pictures. I take it that this can be done later. I have it in mind that the albums will be loose-leaf, so that additions can be made to them in later years.

I have asked the chemist at the paper mill here to check on the last sample of paper which you sent me -- "Charing" paper. I hope to have the result in a day or two -- before I leave here this coming Saturday morning -- and shall let you know what his analysis shows.

It may be that I shall return west from Chicago, toward the end of this month, via Colorado Springs. I gather Mrs. Stewart is there, while Mr. Stewart is making his eastern trip.
