Several additional pictures, with captions, will be forwarded to you in a few days; but you may want to have the type set for ~~these~~ articles in the meantime.

All the matter in this book written by Mrs. Helen Cheney Bayne, up to the first paragraph on page 67, is to be used -- except such parts as are marked "omit." Nothing beyond page 67 in this book is to be used. The enclosed copy of the book is the only one I have; so I am anxious to have it returned in as good condition as possible.
