Dear Miss Gilpin:

I enclose proof of the small type, 10-point Cairo Roman on 12-point slugs. The initial letter is 30-point Cloister bold. It is intended to be two lines deep, 24-point. I hope very much that the Dentan Printing Company has this face or can get it. It seems to be a more elegant letter than the blacker face of which I sent you a sample originally and which is used in the samples which I received from you yesterday.

The margins around the type in the enclosed sample seem to me entirely ample -- in fact, I like the looks of these margins better than the wider ones. Of course, the top margin will be left the same as it is on the page you sent me about Dr. Edwin Weed Cowles, measuring 1-3/4 inches.

Regarding the caption covering the statue of Richard Hooker, of which you sent me a proof, I am not sure about the accuracy of the first line of small type, reading: "He was a brother of John Hooker." As it is important not to have an error, if a definite conclusion can not be arrived at as to what is correct, it will be necessary to leave out the whole page. It will be fine if Mrs. Stewart gets back to Colorado Springs soon enough to help solve this problem.

Also enclosed is the specimen of the title page. I prefer to leave out the word "The" at the top, as well as the little tree -- I do not like ornaments. The words "Family Album" should be of the same ^{type} family as "William Hutchinson Cowles" -- not Italics; and a little more space should be left between those two lines. As you will note, I should like to have the wording "Compiled for His Children and Grandchildren at Spokane, Washington, in 1940" moved down to the line indicated, and the words "Volume One" also moved down as shown. The wording "Photography by Laura Gilpin, Colorado Springs" should be in the next size larger type -- the same series. Please increase a little in size the wording in very small type beginning "To insure durability," and insert before the word "platinum" the words "hand coated."
