My dear Miss Gilpin:

I have your letter of June 25th and was sorry to hear of your illness.

I am sending you a sample of the hinges I mentioned in my first letter. On very thin paper cloth hinges are not necessary but with heavy paper it is the only way to make the book open properly.

I would say that pages amounting to approximately 2" in thickness would make a satisfactory book. However, if weight and size of the book do not matter, it may be increased up to 4". I should like to suggest that a few blank sheets be hinged and bound in at the back of the book in the event more pictures would have to be added.

The price for twelve books bound in cloth with no gold tooling, but the title stamped in gold on the front cover and back, would be \$11.00 per book. In domestic leather and with ~~the~~ some gold tooling, at \$22.50 per book.
