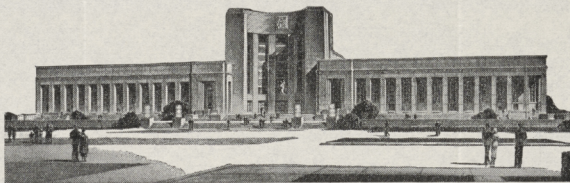

Large Portfolio: No. 12 "Evening. Temple of the Warriors" is not in the shipment; Two prints are in this portfolio that are not on your list:

- 1) "Platform of the Eagles"
- 2) "Evening. Castillo from Temple of the Warriors"

Small Portfolio: Nos. 6, 34, and 22 are missing. Four prints not listed are included:

- 1) "Platform of the Skulls"
- 2) "Montezuma's Castle. Arizona"
- 3) "Peppino Mangravite at Work"
- 4) untitled print showing figure in niche, with burning candle and parted curtains (perhaps this is no. 22, "Santo"?).

I send this notation so that our records will agree. As you will see, we have received a total of 114 instead of 112 prints.

The matters mentioned in your letter I shall take under advisement and let you know about later.
