

My dear Mr. Cowles:-

Your letter with the enclosed proofs came yesterday. I regret to say that neither my printer nor any in town have the 10 point Cairo type face. I agree with you that it is a very handsome face, but the nine point Kenerly is the nearest thing to it. I interpreted your wire to mean that if it was not possible to use this Cairo face, that you O.K.ed the other. We have gone ahead with a considerable amount of the composition, but of-course nothing is printed. However, I am holding everything until I hear from you again. The only other suggestion I have is to have the text set on your press if you definitely want the Cairo. This would entail a good deal of shipping, one way or another which might cause some errors, but I do want your decision on everything before I do anything more here. I am sending you a few pages of proof, and will make the changes as you suggest on the title page and send it on as soon as it is ready. I do not want to push the work too fast at the same time I do want to keep it moving along. A few pages of simple captions are printed, ones you sent back a week ago, but of-course nothing else.

As soon as the proofs reach you, you can send me your decision.
