Dear Mr. Eschmann:-

At last I can send you the order
for the loose leaf bindings. The specifications
are as follows:-

The pages as I am mounting them are 14x11 inches
The selection of cover by my client is the
enclosed leather which you quoted me at \$22.50
per volume.

As it is now decided to have two volumes to
each set, there will be 24 volumes in all.
My client prefers the rounded back such as you
described in an earlier letter allowing for
future inserts.

In a few days I will have the wording for the
outside of the covers. I expect to have all my work
done on Volume one in about two weeks. The pictures
will be mounted, and there will be considerable text
to these volumes which is being done in type. When
I send you the wording for the binding I will enclosed
a proof of the title page to show you the type being used
throughout the books.

If this is sufficient information for you to proceed
with the covers, you may go ahead at you convience as
the covers will be seperate from the contents. You
might send me figures on a simple box to contain the
two volumes so that I may take this up with my client.
