The hand lettering for the duplicate sets of Mrs. Stewarts books is to be done in New York. It is foolish to have the paper sent out here, so I am having it delivered direct there. These books will be bound as you did before, size 14x11. Before I send instructions for cutting the paper I want to be sure just how much of a binding allowance you require. As I recall on the other books it was one inch, but I wish to be sure before I send the order.

The Cowles Albums are coming along, but there have been many additions which is the reason for your not hearing from me before this. It will be several weeks yet before I have Volume One ready, as we are doing a large amount of type setting etc. on this order.

If you will kindly let me know the amount of binding edge you will need for the Stewart Books, I will notify the paper company and have the lettering proceed on this job.
