Dear Miss Gilpin:

I am returning herewith the newspaper articles which you so kindly sent us. I will also send you copies of publicity the Dallas papers give the exhibition. I think it will be in tomorrow's papers.

Mr. Gambrell has asked me to write and ask if we might keep your prints until Feb. 15th. The market season opens here Feb. 1st, and closes Feb. 10th; large numbers of visitors coming here from South America would no doubt enjoy seeing the exhibition. Please let us know at your earliest convenience if an extension of time will be allowed.

We expected the prints to arrive with Express Charges collect. Please advise the amount you paid and we will reimburse you.

At this time I have not been able to change my present $3\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ enlarger to accomodate my 5×7 negatives, as my present condensers will not cover the larger negative. Does your enlarger contain condensers? Local people are endeavoring to discourage my desire for condensers for use with the larger negative. My own idea is that condensers give more brilliant prints. What do you think of the subject?
