Dear Miss Gilpin:

At last, after many delays, we are sending you herewith, by air mail, the pasted up dummy of the Pueblo book. The missing type material went forward to you by air mail this morning. We would appreciate your checking the dummy very carefully for relationship of text to pictures, and sequence of pictures. On the text pages where you have made corrections, the correct type will appear, and on the new text pages, the corrections will be made after you return the galleys.

I hope that you will be able to return the dummy to us immediately, by air mail, as everything is being held up until we have your o.k.

In connection with this dummy, we have the following suggestions for possible additional material if you care to include it. We think the book looks alright now, but you may care to add a few pictures in the places indicated:

Half title backing up frontispiece. We can use a printed half title, or some picture you think appropriate.

Copyright and dedication page. A half-page picture could be used here, but is not necessary.

Page 6, facing the introduction. A full-page picture could be used here but again, is not necessary.

Page 10. The same applies.

Page 74. A picture could be used to face that of Mount Taylor (page 75) with the low thunder clouds. The blue print for Mount Taylor has not as yet been made.

I suggest that we use an additional copy of the map either in the first half-title, the copyright page, page 6, or page 10. The half-title or page 6 would perhaps be most effective.

We seem to have three spare pictures---(1) The Man Leaning Against the Ladder (2) The Woman previously suggested as an end piece and (3) The Man with the Handkerchief Around his Head, recently sent to us.

We await your suggestions concerning these three, and hope that you will rush the material back to us.
