Dear Mr. Meyers:-

I am sorry that I have been so long in getting off your order for post cards, but I was up to my neck in a large job and did not realize that over two weeks had gone by.

Your order is in the mail with this letter. However, I cannot at this time send you the cards of the Ranchos Church, and the only condition upon which I was able to obtain permission to do the interiors was that the Church have the exclusive right to the sale of the cards in Taos. If you care to talk to Father Garcia and see if he will now let you have them, perhaps you can do so. If you would be willing and if you think there would be enough to it to be worth while to split the profit with him, maybe you could obtain them through him. He has had 200 sets so that they are evidently selling well.

I was so anxious to do this set that it seemed the best way to do it.

In the spring I will be down and expect to spend some little time in Taos to work on a lot of new material and do the portraits you spoke of. I have had some heavy re-

sponsibilities during the past year and have
not been able to do this earlier as I had
hoped to do.
