First of all I would like to know what the price is for having looo cards printed. That is most important, because if I can make the card less expensiv in the photographic process and don't have to take thousand at the time I rather do that. I have never sold post cards before and do not know wether I can sell thousand cards in a reasonable time. I wonder wether it could not be arranged that instaed of printing looo of 25 cards they can 500 of 50 different cards. How shall I know which dards sell and what do I do with the thousand cards that dont sell. Thus are my problems. If you would be kind enough to inform me about the price of the cards I can tell you how many and when I want them printed. I have seen your Indian series in Santa Fe but I am wondering why they are not more widely distributed since they are of such excellent quality.
