1. Betatakin, a full view from far enough to show the whole opening of the cave - if possible, not too contrasty shadows and light.

2. a view of the facade of the Governor's Palace at Uxmal, Yucatan, not necessarily the whole, but rather a fine detail of the magnificent "mosaic" frieze.

I do not know whether this is enough specification for you, and leave it to your judgment to send me eventually sample prints in a small size, which I shall be glad to return upon making my choice and pay the expenses.
