Dear Miss Gilpin:

Re: Estate of Francis Gilpin, Deceased.

I filed my report as administrator with the will annexed of the above-named decedent this morning, with the supporting vouchers, and procured the approval of the same by Judge Jones of the County Court and thereupon entered a decree of final settlement, a copy of which is herewith enclosed.

I also filed the request for the retention of the items of personal property which you wished held and which was received in this morning's mail.

Pursuant to the directions in the decree of final settlement, I am enclosing herewith my check as administrator, c.t.a. to your order for \$195.64 representing the balance of the account after the payment of the counsel fees allowed Sherwin and Hungerford by the Court, plus the 2% Colorado State service tax; also form of receipt and release for your execution.

I am not enclosing the \$33.34 note as I am trying to collect that and, of course, it will be for your account without any charge if I am successful. The note will certainly do you no good in Wichita and if I have it and can locate either one of the makers or the car I will probably be able to collect this for you, but to give me a clean bill of health on the Court records the receipt must include this note, the chattel mortgage and the insurance policy.

Will you kindly sign and return the receipt form and acknowledgment receipt of the enclosures.
