The only key which I have is the key to No.3 stall and the same is enclosed herewith in compliance with your request.


With relation to the unpaid note of our soldier friends, investigation has disclosed that the title to this car has not changed so far as any records in this State show, but, of course, that does not help us locate the car nor the makers of the note. You may rest assured I will follow this up and do my best to make collection.

I will file your receipt and that of Sherwin and Hungerford on Monday and obtain an order of discharge which closes the estate.

What would you like me to do with the papers and books that were left here at the time I undertook the administration of the estate and which I would think might be destroyed unless there is some reason, sentimental or otherwise, why you would like them forwarded to Wichita or possibly placed in one of the stalls at Donald's.
