Please pardon my long delay in answering your letter of Sept 28th. This has been following me around on travels which I have been making.

For the past three years I have been away from Colorado Springs on a war job and all my possessions are still in storage including my negative files. However, I have just returned here from Colorado Springs and while I was there I managed to extract the negatives you wish from my files. As it will be the first of the week before I am able to make the prints, I send an airmail letter to ask if the size you specify, 8x11 is requisite or will a contact 8x10 print size be satisfactory? The photographic paper situation is still very limited, and 8x10 is the negative size. I believe that I did make some prints to fit Mr. Connell's books of the size you mention. I shall have to cut down 11x14 paper if you require the larger size.
