Dear Laura:

In the rush of a multitude of details I have neglected writing to you. I am sure that you would enjoy seeing our catalog of the Salon which is being mailed to you under separate cover.

One of the distinct pleasures of our Salon has been the aftermath in planning for our trip to Mexico and to Yucatan. I am wondering if you will give us a little more information as to the things we should see at Merida and surrounding points. Our present schedule would be to fly from Havana arriving at Merida about Sunday, January 12. As our time will be somewhat limited I am wondering about how much time we should allow to see the various ruins there. Would three days be sufficient, or can it be done in two days?

You mentioned going down to Uxmal, if we see the Temple of the Warriors and those ruins would it be worth while to take the other side trips.

Then we would plan to fly to Mexico City about Thursday the 18th or Wednesday if we could leave there early and spend about three days or possibly four at Mexico City, then take the two day trip down to ~~Cuba~~ ^{Guadalupe} and Taxco, then another two day trip down to Manzanillo on the Pacific Coast, all by air.

I don't want to impose upon you too much but I do hope that you can give us some first hand information especially the details about Yucatan.
